

## **The Icarus Account – Duo**

### Hospitality & Technical Rider

This rider is part of the attached agreement for services of The Icarus Account (Artist) and is presented to ensure a smoothly running show. Should you have any questions about any of the provisions, please call your Degy Entertainment Representative. Thank you again for choosing the The Icarus Account.

#### Technical Requirements:

Sound system should be set up a minimum 45 minutes prior to the start of the show to facilitate sound check and an on time start from the artist. Ceiling PA Systems will not be acceptable, a free standing PA system adequate for the size of the room that meets the following criteria must be provided.

1. Two (2) speakers for house PA
2. Two (2) SM 58 vocal microphones with two (2) Boom mic. Stands
3. Two (2) Monitors
4. One (1) Four-channel (at minimum) mixer with power amplifier
5. Two (2) direct input boxes
6. House lights
7. If possible: real piano, (or electric keyboard) if accessible to venue – otherwise The Icarus Account has an electric piano that they may be able to provide, depending on location.
8. Under some circumstances The Icarus Account may be able to provide all of the above mentioned sound equipment for a \$250 buyout fee. Please discuss this option with your Degy Entertainment Representative if desired.

Engineer: A qualified engineer or equivalent must have sound system set up in time for sound check, remain for the duration of performance and dismantle sound system after performance.

Support: There will be no support added of any sort without the consent of Artist.

Other Entertainment: No T.V. screens, radios, CD players or jukeboxes of any kind shall be in use during Artists performance.

Guests: Artist will be allowed ten (10) guests, not including family members of the band, plus five (5) press list spots free admission to the venue (If ticketed event).

Merchandise: Buyer shall provide a table and chair in a well-lit, high traffic area within the venue. Artist shall sell own merchandise and requires that they retain 100% of all sales.

#### Hospitality:

1. Dressing Room: The dressing room must be a lockable room that has a suitable restroom nearby. Only Artist, crew, venue employees and allowed guests will have access to this room. If there is no dressing room available, Artist or Agent should be notified of accommodations.
2. Bottled water & light refreshments, dinner for 2 persons after the show or a \$50 meal buyout.
3. One reserved parking spot close to venue for load in.
4. Accommodations (# of Rooms): One (1) room for two (2) person(s) with two (2) double beds for one (1) night in a Hilton, Holiday Inn or Marriott or similar national hotel chain with an exercise facility and free wi-fi. Non-Smoking room reserved under Trey Turner. If no appropriate accommodations are available a \$150.00 hotel allowance will be added to the agreed price.
